- 9. THERE IS A PROGRESS IN THE REVELATION OF THE BIBLE JUDGES KNEW MORE THAN THE PATRIARCHS THE PROPHETS MORE THAN THE JUDGES THE APOSTLES MORE THAN THE PROPHETS. THE OLD TESTAMENT AND THE NEW TESTAMENT ARE NOT SEPARATE BOOKS, THEY ARE TWO HALVES OF A WHOLE THE "NEW" "ENFOLDED" IN THE OLD AND THE "OLD" "UNFOLDED" IN THE NEW.

# **Definitions**

25. <u>Inspiration</u> – (2315) – inspired by God – divinely breathed.

<u>Broken</u> – (3089) – destroy, dissolve, put off, break up, break down.

**Fulfilled** – (1096) – come to pass, be done.

26. **Study** – (4704) – be diligent, to make effort, be prompt.

**Search** – (350) – examine, judge, ask questions.

Hide-Hid – (6845) – to hoard or reserve, to protect.

Ready - (2092) - prepared, ready, readiness.

Meditate – (1897) – to ponder, imagine.

**Read** – (7121) – proclaim, read, preach, pronounce, say.

<u>Hear</u> – (8085) – attention, harken, understand, discern.

Know – (1097) – understand, know.

**Grow** – (837) – to increase, to become greater.

**Mature** – to grow from childhood to manhood.

**Equipped**-**Perfecting** – (2677) – a fitting or preparing fully.

Ministers – (1249) – pastor, teacher, deacon, servant.

Ambassadors – (4243) – a representative, "Elder-experienced."

### Note – Four things we observe from God's Word

- 1. **Precepts** (6490) commandment, mandate, statute. (Ps. 119:4)
  - a. Obey (3980) to submit to authority. (Acts 5:29)
- 2. Warnings (3560) instructions. (Col. 1:28)
  - a. <u>Heed</u> (991) take heed, beware of. (1 Cor. 10:12)
- 3. **Promises** (1862) a promise made. (2 Peter 1:3-4)
  - a. Claim to demand or ask for as rightfully belonging or due one
- 4. **Principles** (4747) something orderly in arrangement (Heb. 6:1)
  - a. Follow (190) to be in the same way with. (John 10:27)

(<u>Principle</u> – the ultimate source, origin, or cause of something,)

# "THE JUST SHALL LIVE BY FAITH"

- 1. The just shall live by faith. (Hab. 2:4; Rom. 1:17; Gal. 3:11; Heb. 10:39)
  - a. Romans explains "the just".
  - b. Galatians explains "shall live".
  - c. Hebrews explains "by faith".
- 2. Christians can experience victory, liberty, and security.
- 3. The believer is not only saved by faith but must also <u>live by faith</u>.
- 4. The believer who lives by faith will go on to perfection, full maturity, completeness. The believer who lives by sight will draw back and live a defeated, wasted, meaningless, life.
- 5. True Bible faith is confident obedience to God's Word in spite of the circumstances and consequences.
- 6. Faith operates quite simply. God speaks and we hear His Word and act on it no matter what the circumstances are or what the consequences may be. We obey God's Word just the same and trust Him to do what is right and best.
- 7. \*Faith is only as good as it's object, and the object of our faith is God. It is our total response to what God has revealed to us in His Word.
- 8. Bible faith (Hebrews 11:1) consist of "substance" and "evidence".
  - a. <u>Substance</u> gives support like a foundation to a house. (Matt. 7:24-27) Jesus Christ is a believer's foundation (1 Cor. 3:11) that is built upon "The Rock" (1 Cor. 10:4). This gives a believer the confidence and assurance that he will stand and not fall. By faith a believer will experience all that God promises.
  - b. <u>Evidence</u> means <u>"conviction"</u> which leads to "<u>convincing</u>". Being convicted of one's sins is not enough, he must be convinced to act upon this conviction by believing, confession, and repentance. This God-given faith give us assurance that God will keep His Word and all of His promises. (Phil. 1:6)

# "GROW" (2 Peter 3:18; Col. 1:23)

# 1. **Grow and Mature**

- a. <u>2 Peter 3:18</u> = grow in grace and in knowledge.
- b. Results of failure to grow and mature:
  - i. You remain babes in Christ, still on milk, become trouble makers in the church, walk as carnal men. (1 Cor. 3:1-3)
  - ii. Unable to hear and understand deep spiritual preaching and teachings of God's Word, need to be taught again, still need milk not meat, unskilled in the word of righteousness, cannot discern good or evil. (Hebrews 5:11-14)
  - iii. We should desire the "spiritual milk" of the Word which has life, gives life, and nourishes life, this alone can help us grow. (1 Peter 2:1-2)

## 2. To grow and mature you must:

- a. Hear God's Word = Mark 12:29; Rev. 2:7; Luke 11:28; Neb. 8:1-4
- b. Read God's Word = Neh. 8;1-4; Eph. 3:1-5; 1 Thess. 5:27; 1 Tim. 4:13\*
- c. **Search** God's Word = \*Acts 17:11; John 5:39; 1 Peter 1:10-12
- d. Study God's Word = 2 Timothy 2:15
- e. Memorize God's Word = Deut. 6:6; \*Psalms 119:11
- f. Meditate on God's Word = \*Josh. 1:8; Psalms 1;1-3

# 3. Four things we observe from God's Word:

- a. <u>Precepts</u> for us to <u>obey</u> (Matt.22:37-40; Acts 1:8; Psalms 119:4)
- b. Warnings for us to heed (Numbers 32:23; Gal. 5:7)
- c. Promises for us to claim (Hebrews 13:5; Phil. 4:19)
- d. Principles for us to follow (Josh. 1:8; 1 John 2:15-16)

NOTE God desires all of us to grow from new-born babes in Christ to full maturity

In Christ so that we may become useful, productive servants in His Kingdom

work – Soul winners (Proverbs 11:30; John 15:16; Acts 1:8; Mark 16:15;

Matthew 28:19-20)

# "THE CHURCH"

- 1. Jesus Christ Himself said "I will build My Church". (Matthew 16:18; read verses 13-18)
- 2. The church is referred to as:
  - a. The body of Christ which consist of all believers as members of that one body. (1 Cor. 12:12-27)
  - b. God's building. (1 Cor. 3:9)
  - c. The temple of God. (1 Cor. 6:19)
  - d. A spiritual house (1 Peter 2:5), believers are the lively stones God is using to build up that house. (1 Peter 2:5)
- 3. In order for the church to be secure and to be able to stand firm it must be built on:
  - a. A firm foundation (1 Cor. 3:11; Eph. 2:20)
  - b. Set on a solid Rock (Matthew 16:16-18; 1 Cor. 10:4)
  - c. Must have a perfect cornerstone (Mt 21:42; Mk 12:10; Lk 20:17; cF Psalms 118:22-23) (Acts 4:11; cF Isa. 28:16) (Eph. 2:20; 1 Peter 2:6,7)
- **NOTE** By studying the above scriptures and fully understanding that your faith is firmly established and secure. Know that you can stand on the Word of God with confidence and assurance that you can live a "victorious life" Amen!

(Phil. 1:6) (Phil. 4:13)

REMEMBER – As new believers you are babes in Christ knowing very little right now, but as grow in your knowledge of God and His Holy Word (2 Peter 3:18), you will increase in understanding these scriptures.
